NOTICE TO OIL AND GAS OPERATORS

Texas Faces Dangerous Winter Storm

On Friday, Governor Greg Abbott declared a disaster declaration for all 254 counties in the state due to the ongoing winter storm: https://gov.texas.gov/news/post/governor-abbott-issues-disaster-declaration-continues-to-deploy-resources-as-severe-winter-weather-impacts-texas.

The Railroad Commission of Texas (RRC) encourages all oil and gas operators under the RRC's jurisdiction to take the following safety precautions:

- Monitor local, state and national weather reports for updates on potential severe weather impacts, including the National Weather Service and Texas Division of Emergency Management;
- Heed all watches, warnings, and orders issued by local emergency officials;
- Secure all personnel, equipment, and facilities to prevent injury or damage; and,
- Monitor and maintain operations for potential impacts, as safety permits.

During an emergency meeting Friday night, RRC temporarily amended Rule 2 of Order 489 to elevate electric generation facilities serving human needs customers to a higher priority. This action was taken to ensure the availability of gas supplies to gas-fired generation facilities in Texas during this critical period. The Commission took this action to prioritize the protection of public health and safety during this extreme weather event.
