Background information about the microfilm

About the forms:

P-13 is the form designation given to the Application of Landowner to Condition an Abandoned Well for Fresh Water Production.

The current version of the form and included filing instructions are located in the RRC's Oil and Gas Forms.

About the Film:

The film contains P-13's from 1972 through 2001. Outside of these date ranges, P-13's may be found alongside plugging documents, or with other documents in which a P-13 was filed.

There are a total of 9 rolls of film containing P-13's during this time range.

The images on the rolls are organized by Year or Group of Years, District, Operator name, Field Name, and Lease Name.

This organization is maintained throughout the series.
