## Form H-9, Certificate of Compliance, Statewide Rule 36 (Hydrogen Sulfide), Online Filing Available

As part of the Texas Oilfield Relief Initiative, the Railroad Commission of Texas (RRC) is encouraging oil and gas operators to file the Form H-9, *Certificate of Compliance, Statewide Rule 36 (Hydrogen Sulfide)*, online using the RRC Online System at <u>https://webapps.rrc.texas.gov/security/login.do</u>. To view the *Certificate of Compliance Statewide Rule 36 User Guide*, visit the RRC website at <u>http://webapps.rrc.texas.gov/H9/resources/docs/H-9 User Guide.pdf</u>.

The Form H-9 is required to certify that an operator has complied or will comply with 16 Texas Administrative Code §3.36 (Statewide Rule 36).

Existing users with accounts in the RRC Online System do not need to designate a new security administrator. The organization's security administrator needs only to assign rights for filing online through their administration accounts to grant their users access. If your company needs to set up security administrator rights to file online using the RRC Online System, view the instructions on RRC website at <a href="https://www.rrc.texas.gov/forms/online-filing-at-rrc/">https://www.rrc.texas.gov/forms/online-filing-at-rrc/</a>.
