Winter Weather Forecasted This Week

The National Weather Service has indicated many regions of Texas including **West Texas/Panhandle, through Central/North Texas and Hill Country** will experience freezing temperatures by Thursday night. Single digit temperatures expected for West Texas and the Panhandle by Friday morning.

The Railroad Commission of Texas (RRC) askes operators to:

- Monitor local, state and national weather reports for updates on potential severe weather impacts, including the National Weather Service and Texas Division of Emergency Management; and
- Monitor and maintain operations for potential impacts, as safety permits.

For guidance, the RRC has previously issued notices with best practices that can be utilized to protect against freezing conditions.
