*Notes: 1) Native Gas volumes are included in Working Gas volumes with the exception of Houston Pipe Line's Bammel facility and Natural Gas Pipeline Co. of America's North Lansing facility, in which the native gas is part of the non-working resident gas. 2) Due to an expansion of the North Lansing facility, 9700 MMcf of Resident Gas Inventory was converted to Working Gas volume as of June 2007. 3) Tres Palacios Storage LLC Salt Cavern facility was added to the report as of October 2008. 4) The City of Brady facility was added back to the report as of the August 2015 issue. 5) WWM Operating, LLC was added to the report as of February 2022. 6) Enbridge Pipeline LP changed to Sulphur River Exploration, Enlink Midstream Services changed to SWG Pipeline, PB Energy changed to WSP USA Inc, Underground Services Markham changed to Kinder Morgan Texas Pipeline, and Chevron Keystone Gas Service changed to Kinder Morgan Keystone Gas Storage. 7) New entry: 20-0044 Atmos Pipeline Texas, Bethel Salt Dome 1b.
