



INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMITTING SHAPEFILES ONLINE

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INTRODUCTION

The Commission requires that pipeline operators provide shapefiles and an overview map of all pipelines included under each permit. The Texas Pipeline Mapping System (TPMS) is updated daily using this information. The submitted shapefiles should include all active and abandoned lines.

GEOSPATIAL FILE TYPE

The Commission requires all four geospatial file types (.shp, .shx, .dbf, .prj) in addition to the required attributes for each pipeline segment. Together, these four file types make up one shapefile set. This shapefile format is a geographic information system (GIS) industry standard. *You must submit only one set of shapefiles per permit.*
