CERTIFICATION: I certify that I am a Master or Journeyman Plumber currently licensed by the Texas State Board of Plumbing Examiners, or a Class A or B Air Conditioning and Refrigeration Contractor currently licensed by the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation. I have read the current edition of the Railroad Commission's *LP-Gas Safety Rules* and will comply with the requirements of those rules. If I lose my qualified status as a Master or Journeyman Plumber or Class A or B Air Conditioning and Refrigeration Contractor, the registration card will be returned immediately to the Commission, and I will surrender all rights and privileges of registration. I understand that the registration accrues only to me and is non-transferable.

Additionally, applicant agrees that this application may be executed by electronic signature, which shall be considered as an original signature for all purposes and shall have the same force and effect as an original signature.

All LPG registrations expire at midnight on May 31 of each year.
